LIBERTY HEIGHTS HOA POOL RULES

The Liberty Heights Homeowners Association is not responsible for accidents or injuries at the pool. Patrons use these facilities at their own risk. Please treat this area as if it were your own home; treat others as you would want to be treated.

- 1. This area is for members and their non-resident guest only. Maximum of 4 non-resident guests per household, allowed at any time. All guests must be accompanied by the adult household member(s) (meaning 18 years of age and older).
- 2. Pool hours are 8:00am 9:00pm
- 3. Children under age 15 must be accompanied by an adult (meaning 18 years of age and older). Children age 15 or older may use the pool without adult supervision, provided that NO guests are accompanying the child.
- 4. No pets allowed.
- 5. No glass containers or glass items are allowed in the fenced in pool area.
- 6. No smoking or vaping in the fenced in pool area.
- 7. Non-visible (cup or concealed) consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed on the pool deck.
- 8. Food and beverages are allowed in the pool area. ALL trash must be placed in the trash containers provided.
- 9. Appropriate attire required; no cut-offs allowed in pool; wearing applicable swim diapers REQUIRED!
- 10. No diving, running, horseplay, excessive noise levels, abusive language or abuse of pool property.
- 11. No skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, or other vehicles allowed in pool area.
- 12. Adult members have the responsibility to enforce rules to ensure the safety of all patrons.
- 13. Homeowners are legally responsible for damages caused by family or guest.
- 14. No parties are allowed due to limited space and consideration of all homeowners.
- 15. Baby Pool ages five (5) and under.
- 16. No large rafts, floats, or hard footballs are allowed. Pool balls, toys, small floats and noodles are allowed. Please use discretion on the number of people in the pool when using these items.
- 17. Individuals (homeowners and/or guests) caught vandalizing or trespassing on pool property can face the following actions up to and including: suspension from pool facilities, fined by the HOA and/or law enforcement involvement.
- 18. Violating any pool rule or failing to obey monitors (when in place) may result in loss of swimming privileges and or fines by the HOA.
- 19. All maintenance, cleaning and violation concerns or issues with the pool need to be directed to the property manager at PSMT.
