DUMPSTER RULES

- Resident Use Only
- Securely bag your trash and place it inside the dumpster.
- No large items (Ex: TV's, computers, furniture, bedding, etc.)
 - o If it does not fit in the side door of the dumpster, do not put it in the dumpster. It will be your responsibility to properly dispose of any large items. Contact your City for proper disposal locations. Anyone found placing large items inside or outside of the dumpster will be subject to fines per the association's fine policy.
- If the dumpster is full, please notify the management company
- Do not over fill or place trash of any kind on the ground
- NO PARKING is allowed in front of the dumpster

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN GENERAL WASTE CONTAINERS:

- Oil rags, etc. (any type of oily drilling waste)
- Tires
- Appliances (white goods)
- Hazardous Waste
- Liquid Waste
- Industrial Waste (including dirt)
- Chemical Products
- Fluorescent tubes
- Oil Filters (unless drained for 24 hours)
- Furniture such as bed frames, mattress, desk, chairs, etc.
- Construction debris such as but not limited to wood, sheetrock, doors, etc.
- Paint, Thinner or remover cans (unless RCRA empty, solidified or triple rinsed)
- Herbicides and pesticides
- Radioactive materials, naturally occurring (NORM)

Anyone found dumping any of the above items will be subject to HOA fines as well as any city of EPA fines.

- Batteries
 - o Advance Auto Parts
 - o Reilly Auto Parts
 - o Any auto parts dealer
- Used Oil
 - Wal-Mart Auto Centers
 - o Check with Local oil changing locations
- Paint & Paint Products
 - o Latex Let dry and place in trash with lid off
 - Oil Based Treat as hazardous waste, check with city
 - Turpentine, Thinners, Shellacs, and Varnishes Treat as hazardous waste, check with city
- Tires
 - o Check with local tire dealers and salvage yards, there may be a charge for disposal
